Behind the Scenes

One Main Truth:

We should fix our eyes on Jesus as we walk in his way.

Meaning:

Worries and distractions can pull our attention away from Jesus. When we realize there is greater value in laying up treasure in heaven rather than pursuing earthly things that fade (Matthew 6:19-21), we commit to live according to God's word and for his glory. Yielding to Jesus takes faith, but, as Jesus said, "Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed" (John 20:29b).

Life Application:

In tumultuous times of transition, trial, or temptation, we can keep our focus on and submit to Jesus. Remembering nothing can compete with our heavenly reward will help us live for what endures.
